April 2026

Co-Curricular & Operational Guidelines

Daily Assembly:

The mandatory 25-minute morning prayer assembly provides an excellent window to integrate Indian classical music into the daily routine. Setting school anthems or daily prayers to foundational scales like *Raag Yaman* or *Raag Pahadi* can foster a deeper cultural connection for the students.

Curriculum Nomenclature:

To align with modern pedagogical approaches, specific periods on the daily bell schedule should reflect updated nomenclature. For instance, traditional "Computer Science" blocks operate as **Digital Literacy**, and "EVS" for foundational stages is branded as **The World Around Us**.

No Bag Days (2nd & 4th Saturdays):

These days are strictly reserved for experiential learning without the burden of academic textbooks.

- **Kaushal Bodh (Skill Awareness):** Utilize these Saturdays to prep students for upcoming skill fairs and hands-on vocational training.
- **Thematic Integration:** Activities should rotate between language development, scientific awareness ("Main Vaigyanik Banunga"), and "Rajasthan Ko Pehchano" (Know Rajasthan) initiatives. Ensure that 40 minutes at the end of these designated days are utilized for structured club meetings or House activities.
